- 4. To instill in the young minds that human beings are inter dependent beings and that no one is to be discriminated against based on the color of the skin, religion, the place of birth and status.

PROSPECTUS

EDUCATION MINISTRY OF HOLY CROSS

In 1837 Fr. Basil Moreau, the Founder of the Congregation of Sante Croix, (Holy Cross), envisioned education as the main source of empowering the young for a better and brighter world and to uplift the broken society of France. He prepared men and women religious, who wanted to see the world as he saw it, developed and empowered. To this end he founded a Congregation of priests to do pastoral and educational ministry, Marianite sisters to do educational and domestic ministry and he incorporated the Brothers of St. Joseph to do formal and non-formal education. These three branches were brought under the one umbrella of Sante Croix (Holy Cross). Thus Fr. Basil Moreau became a visionary who constantly spoke on the theme of unity as a family to keep the members focused on this meaningful mission of sowing the seed of LOVE and PEACE.

France: In 1789, the French Revolution, which rebelled against the political and religious oppression of the day, stripped the country to the bare minimum and created destruction and chaos throughout France. It was a time of great confusion and division in the church, a period of uncertainty and fear, a period of execution and persecution, and a period when the churches, schools, and seminaries were all nationalized. Religious congregations and organizations were banned.

In 1802, Napoleon's Concordat made a breakthrough for the revival of the church organizations. There was a mushrooming of charismatic persons and organizations to answer to the needs of the devastating situation of the society. Education was one of the greatest needs of the time. The religious leaders focused all their resources on education and on restoring the fallen society.

One such religious leader was Basil Anthony Moreau, born on February 11, 1799, to Louis and Louise Moreau. He was the ninth of their fourteen children and showed a quick intelligence and qualities of leadership along with a pious character. He was ordained a priest on August 12, 1821, at the age of 22. Since the formation of the clergy was one of the urgent needs of the time, he was asked by his bishop to train and educate the youth of his time for the priesthood. Thus, he became a professor at the philosophy house of the seminary in the Diocese of Le Mans, France.

Soon the international character of the community began to evolve. The Holy Cross priests, sisters, and brothers established the foundation in Algeria (1840), the United States (1842), Canada (1847), Chile (1943), East Bengal (1853) and in India (1960).

Saint Andre School, Bodhjungnagar, Tripura: Saint Andre School, Bodhjungnagar was started as a result of the felt need of the people of surrounding villages by a local managing committee in the year 1986, with 12 children and one master. Due to a lack of proper facilities and experience, the people offered the school to the Holy Cross Fathers in the year 1991. Since then Saint Andre school has been managed and administered by the Holy Cross Educational Foundation. The members of the Society of the Fathers of Holy Cross are Catholics, a minority community.

II. HOLY CROSS TRADITION IN EDUCATION

For many of us in the Holy Cross, mission expresses itself in the education of youth in schools, colleges, and universities. For others, our mission as educators takes place in parishes and other ministries (Constitutions of the Congregation of Holy Cross 2, 16).

Teaching in the Holy Cross tradition is clearly a ministry of the Congregation. In our teaching and preaching, we confront the truth of the Gospel.

Jesus our master, called his disciples to be fishers of men and proclaimers of the Kingdom of God (Mk. 3/1 3-1 5). Jesus taught with authority about God's Kingdom (Lk. 1/22). He called the disciples to be with him, to bring liberty to the captives and to proclaim the good news to the poor. Fr. Moreau wrote, "We shall always place education side by side with instructions; the mind will not be cultivated at the expense of the heart" (Circular Letters.36).

The Holy Cross tradition of operating a school and teaching young people began in post-revolutionary France at a time in which Christian education was a crucial concern. For Fr. Moreau, the vocation of a teacher was a special call from God as important as God's call to the religious life. Fr. Moreau defined a Holy Cross education when he said that true education consisted in forming the hearts of young people.

Holy Cross Education has the following characteristics:

- A Holy Cross School serves a diverse population.
- A Holy Cross School finds ways of providing educational opportunities for the poor and disadvantaged, even at the cost of considerable sacrifice.
- A Holy Cross School is a community and family.
- A Holy Cross School's service includes helping students to get the best education possible.
- A Holy Cross School selects and retains teachers with great care.
- A Holy Cross School helps students become active and informed citizens and instill in them a strong sense of personal self-worth and feelings of accomplishment.
- A Holy Cross School provides an orderly learning environment with efficient and well-maintained facilities.

SCHOOL REGULATIONS

Pattern

The School includes classes from K.G-1 to Class XII. The curriculum of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi, is followed from K.G-1 to Class-XI I. English is the medium of instruction; Bengali and Hindi are also included as languages.

Course of Study

- 1. One year of Nursery cum KG-I (48 months completed, 4+).
- 2. One year of KG II (4+ and 5+)
- 3. Ten years till Secondary Examination.
- 4. Two years for Senior Secondary Examination.
- 5. Public examinations are held at the end of Class X (CBSE) & Class XII (CBSE).
- 6. For the Secondary Examination, every student must take the following subjects:

- 1) ENGLISH COMM. (Sub Code 101),
- 2) BENGALI(Sub Code 05)OR HINDI (Sub Code 85),
- 3) SOCIAL STUDIES (Sub Code 87)
- 4) MATHEMATICS (Sub Code 41),
- 5) SCIENCE (Sub Code 86),
- 6) INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY(Sub Code 402)
- 7) MORAL SCIENCE/CATECHISM.
- 8) ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION,
- 7. For Senior Secondary sections subjects available are:
 - 1. History (Subject Code027),
 - 2. Political Science (Subject Code 028),
 - 3. Geography (Subject Code 029),
 - 4. Economics (Subject Code 030),
 - 5. Physical Education (Subject Code 048),
 - 6. English (Subject Code 301),
 - 7. Information Technology (Subject Code 802).

Rules and regulations of the syllabus and assessment of students' performance are one under the standard set by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi.

Academic Year and Timings

The School academic year commences in April and ends in March.

School timing: 08.00 A.M. to 01.30 P.M.

The second Saturday is a holiday and parents visit hostellers.

These timings are subject to change whenever necessary; it may not always be possible to intimate the change in advance.

Admission Regulations

The minimum age for admission to K.G-I is 4 years plus (40-44 months) as of April 1st. Together with the application, a photocopy of the birth certificate is to be submitted.

In case of admissions to Class 1 and above,

- 1. The original mark sheet and Transfer Certificate from the school last attended is required.
- 2. Adhar Card
- 3. Birth Certificate

To be submitted at the time of admission. Without the above documents, admissions shall not be given to anyone in the school.

Admission and assignments to a particular section of the class are entirely reserved for the school authorities. The correct date of birth is to be given at the time of admission. No changes in the date of birth will be entertained. The date of birth once registered cannot be altered.

Office Hours

The Principal's office hours are from 08.45 A.M. to 01.00 P.M. The School office hours are from 08.00 A.M. to 02.30 P.M.

Rules for payment of School Fees

- 1. Fees will be received by the Office in charge ONLY. And each month, fees have to be cleared before 15th failing which a fine of Rs. 10.00 per month will be levied on all late payments.
- 2. The School Fees cover twelve calendar months. No reduction is made for holidays or broken periods.
- 3. No students will be allowed to sit for any terminal examination unless all school dues have been cleared before the respective examination.
- 4. The school fees and other dues are liable to be revised at any time.
- 5. Certificates or results will be withheld from pupils who have arrears of fees. Fees for the vacation months are to be paid in advance.
- 6. Pupils joining or leaving the school during the year will have to pay all the fees of year.
- 7. Parents /Guardians may pay all the fees at a time at the beginning of the year in which case a 5% reduction will be made.

Academic Session

- The School Academic Year for classes I VIII is divided into two halves with two Periodic Tests, Half-yearly and Final exam.
- The School Academic Year for Class IX and X is divided into two Periodic Tests, Half-yearly, Preparatory exam, and Final exam.
- Class **XI-XII** is divided into two Quarterly, one half-yearly, a Preparatory exam and one final exam.

Vacations:

The School has got short vacations in the month of May-June for two weeks, Puja vacations in October, in December 3 weeks Christmas vacations and a long vacation for summer.

Promotion to higher class depends upon:

- a. Regularity in attendance (minimum 85%)
- b. Those students who are sick should get a minimum of 75% attendance to sit in the exam. They shall provide the doctors medical prescriptions and the bills of the medicine purchased in original to be considered as sick.
- c. Quality of day-to-day participation in class.
- d. Written work and projects assigned by the subject teacher.

- e. Satisfactory performance at the class tests.
- f. The minimum mark required for a pass for subjects out of 100 is 33 and for subjects out of 50 are 17.
- g. The Progress Report of Half Yearly will be shown to the guardians in the school only. During that time the guardians get an opportunity to talk to the class teacher concerned. However, guardians of classes IX and X should meet their wards teachers a minimum of four times a year.

Home Works and Assignments

- 1. Homework is an assignment given by the teacher to be done at home; it may include writing, reading, memorizing, drawing, etc.
- 2. Every student is expected to do the Home Work regularly; it is the sign of a good student.
- 3. Those who have not done their homework will not be allowed to sit in the class.
- **4.** The guardians must make sure that the students do the homework.
- **5.** If a student is found to be not doing the homework regularly a warning will be issued to the student through the guardian and after a total of such three warnings in an academic session in any subject, the student will be issued a Transfer Certificate.
- **6.** Silly reasons like headaches and visits to relative's house and any kind of functions will not be considered as valuable reasons for not doing the homework.

Handwriting & use of pen, pencil, etc.

- 1. Every student is expected to submit a page of Hand Writing as instructed by the school.
- 2. If any student doesn't submit the Handwriting, the student should write 5 pages minimum while submitting the same Hand Writing copy the next time.
- 3. All classes the Hand Writing is to be done with a pencil only.
- 4. If there is no improvement in the Handwriting of a student it is to be brought to the notice of the guardian and Principal by the teacher concerned.
- 5. The Hand-writing copies are submitted to the teachers and given back to the students by the class leaders and the defaulter's names are given to the Class Teacher by the leaders.
- 6. Students of **K.G-1** to class-II are allowed to use the only pencil for writing.
- 7. Students of Class-III to Class- VII are allowed to use only ink-pens or gel pens and not ball pens.
- 8. The students are allowed to write notes only in black and blue colours.
- 9. Students are not allowed to use red or green colour pens, blade, knife, correction ink and calculator in the school.
- 10. Students are not allowed to use in the school geometry box, scales, and notebooks with mathematic equations and formulas.

K.G-I and K.G-II

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The students of K.G-I and K.G-II will have the same uniform on all days. They are not given ties.

I to V

The students of classes I to IV are to wear the check shirts, with black skirt/ half pants, new tie maroon with school name imprinted, new belt with new socks with a red border and black shoes with lace on Monday and Tuesday. On Wednesday and Thursday, the white dress will be put. And on Friday and Saturday, they will wear black shoes, black socks with maroon border, black skirt/ half pants with the school colour (T-shirt). Maroon sweater for winter.

VI to X

The students of class V to X are to wear the check shirts, with black skirt/pants, new maroon tie with school name imprinted, new belt with new socks with a red border and black shoes with lace on Monday and Tuesday. On Wednesday and Thursday, the white dress will be put. And on Friday and Saturday, they will wear black shoes, a black tracksuit/pants with the school colour (T-shirt). Maroon sweater for winter.

XI to XII

Boys will wear small blue stripes on the white shirt, black pants stitches loose, blue tie with school name imprinted, black socks with a red border, black shoes and black belt provided by the school and **girls** will wear salwar blue stripes with collar, blue dupatta, and black shoe and socks on Monday and Tuesday. On Wednesday and Thursday boys put white dress and girls put white salwar and P.T shoes. And on Friday and Saturday boys come with a house T-shirt and black pants and girls with a house T-shirt and black tracksuit.

Every student is expected to wear the school ID card around the neck every day in the school once it is given to them.

Skirts for girls should be knee-length.

Leave Rules

- 1. Leave of absence will be granted only for serious reasons on previously written applications from parents or guardians.
- **2.** Except for reasons of ill health and unavoidable circumstances, a previous written application from the guardian is required for any leave of absence.
- 3. In case of absence without leave, the students, on returning to the school, must produce the reason of absence certificate from his/her Parents or Guardian.
- **4.** If any pupil has been absent for he/she should not enter the class without first obtaining permission from the Class Teacher or Principal as required.
- **5.** If a student is absent for more than a day then he/she should get permission from the Principal.
- **6.** Those who are absent because of sickness or accidents should produce a certificate from the doctor.
- 7. A student returning to school after contracting a contagious or infectious disease should produce a Doctor's Fitness Certificate permitting him/her to attend classes, without any danger to other students.

- **8.** For those staying in rented houses will not be given leave for visiting their houses on school days.
- **9.** Attendance on opening and closing day is compulsory, failure to which without sufficient reason and prior information other than sickness with the medical certificate a fine will be charged up to 500 rupees.

Library Rules

- 1. Library books may be issued once in two weeks.
- 2. When taking a book, if any defect is noticed, it should be brought to the notice of the Librarian.
- 3. Books lost or damaged must be replaced by the borrower.
- 4. Books overdue may be returned on any library day with a fine of Rs. 5/- per day.

DISCIPLINE

- 1. Pupils are expected to regularly prepare their lessons & do their homework.
- 2. All the students are expected to come to the school in proper uniform. Boys should cut their hair close to the skull and girls the hair should be tied. No tattoos are allowed and no nail polish or use of lipstick is allowed.
- 3. It is obligatory to wear the uniform prescribed for the season on class days and at school functions. Those who are not correctly dressed in conformity with the regulation of the school will not be admitted to the classes.
- 4. Pupils who travel by the school buses are expected to observe strict discipline inside the buses as well as at the bus stops. Those who do not deport themselves in an orderly manne0r are liable to forfeit their transport facilities. No pupil is allowed to get down at any bus stop other than one indicated in the application form.
- 5. Those who do not report to class for one week after the vacation will have their names struck off the rolls. The Principal reserves the right to consider applications for the readmission of such pupils.
- 6. Pupils should treat their classrooms as sacred places. They are expected to maintain silence and order in the classrooms. Those who disturb the class will be sent out of the classroom. During the absence of a teacher from the class, pupils must obey the leader appointed to maintain good order.
- 7. Running, playing or shouting in the school building is not permitted. During the class hours, pupils should move along the corridors in silence and order.
- 8. Participation in games, physical training, cultural activities, and socially useful productive works, are compulsory. The exemption will be granted on medical grounds only.
- 9. Pupils are strictly Porbidden to form any association or to engage themselves in any group activity or to raise funds for any purpose without the permission of the Principal or an officer authorized by him on his behalf.
- 10. Pupils are not allowed to buy, sell or exchange any articles among themselves in the school premises.
- 11. No one should write on the furniture or walls or damage any school articles. Damage by accident should be reported to the Principal at once. Any damage caused to school property or the property of another student must be compensated by the offender.
- 12. Pupils shall not circulate books, magazines or periodicals in the school without the permission of the Principal.

- 13. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, theft, dishonesty, immoral conduct, insubordination, neglect of homework, disobedience or disrespect towards the members of the staff, unruly behavior or immoral influence justifies dismissal.
- 14. English should be spoken in the school bus and the school premises at all times to acquire fluency in speaking the language.
- 15. Certificates of any sort will be issued only two days after the application has been submitted to the office. A fee of Rs. 50/- will be charged for any extract from the school registers.
- 16. A student missing from the classroom during class hours without the permission of the teacher concerned even if it is for practices of any kind will be liable to punishment.
- 17. Without written permission from the Principal, pupils will not be allowed to leave school during school hours.
- 18. Pupils of this school are not permitted to bring Mobile phones, Electronic gadgets, unauthorized CDs, magazines, Fancy watches, and Gold ornaments to the school and other valuable goods.
- 19. Students caught copying during the exam shall be debarred from the school for the current year.
- 20. Students who are caught for indiscipline of any sort shall be sent for counseling to a professional counselor and should get a certificate of counseling from the counselor and submit the same to Principal to join back the school.
- 21. Any students who are engaged in substance abuse (alcohol, tobacco products, ganja, tablets, and injections) shall be rusticated from the school with immediate effect. No opportunities for the betterment shall be given taking into consideration the overall wellbeing of the rest of the students.

SCHOOL BUS

- 1. Each student is to fill in an application form afresh every year to avail of the school bus facility. The form will be available in the school office.
- 2. The school pays 12 months' salary to the bus drivers and conductors. Therefore, the school bus fee is to be paid for 12 months.
- 3. Change of bus point is not allowed without prior permission of the school authority.
- 4. Guardians are not allowed to come by the school bus in any circumstances.
- 5. Please be on time at the bus points for boarding and disembarking.
- 6. Students traveling by the school bus are expected to maintain decorum. Any complaint from the side of the driver or teachers traveling by the same bus will result in the non availability of transportation facilities.
- 7. There are only limited seats available for the school bus. So seats will be given on a first-come-first-serve basis.

RESPONSIBILITY OF CLASS LEADERS

- 1. Special attention shall be paid by class teachers in choosing suitable leaders.
- 2. Leaders must be as far as possible exemplary in conduct and industrious in their studies.
- 3. They must be able to command respect in the class.
- 4. They are employed for all assistance in the class eg. Maintaining discipline, collecting or distributing books, attending to cleanliness and neatness of the classroom, bringing

- charts, maps, reporting to concerned authorities about various needs of the class, up keeping of bulletin boards, etc.
- 5. They must rubout the writing on the blackboard immediately after each period.
- 6. The leaders will write each day on the blackboard, the date and the number of students present in the class.
- 7. The leaders will be responsible for all the happenings in the class during the absence of the teacher.
- 8. Periodic meetings of the leaders will be held under the guidance of appointed supervisors where methods and means are discussed and adopted for improving discipline and redressing grievances.
- 9. It is incumbent on all leaders to report to the principal, the teacher-in-charge or the class teacher any breach of discipline noticed even during recess.
- 10. In the event of a teacher being absent, they must inform the Headmistress within the first five minutes from the commencement of the periods.

Responsibility of the SPL and ASPL

- 1. He/ She should ensure that the leaders carry out their duties responsibly and impartially.
- 2. He/ She should command the whole school in discipline at prayer assemblies every morning and all-school gatherings.
- 3. He/ She should be constantly alert, observant and sensitive to the needs of the school and act promptly after consulting and getting orders from the principal.
- 4. He/ She should show exemplary behavior with head held high, providing a shining example of leadership, trust, courtesy, love, and goodness.
- 5. He/ She should bring to the notice of the teacher's minor day-to-day problems of students like fights, misunderstandings, injuries, damage to school property, missing articles, etc.
